## Primer on the Law of Arbitration: Avoiding a Walk into the Black Abyss

Arbitration is on the rise in Ontario. About 70% of all decided cases have taken place in the last 5 years. When engaged, however, lawyers often walk into the arbitration process without understanding the basics and the critical differences from traditional litigation. Typically an arbitration takes 7-9 months to complete, while a court case takes an average of 40 months.

The authors of **Annotated Ontario Arbitration Act, 1991** will share their knowledge and insight from having collected, reviewed and annotated all of the case law decided under the Ontario **Arbitration Act, 1991** and its equivalent in other provinces.
